My current role as a Director is now focused on building brand awareness so that Exante achieves it's aim of becoming the number one provider of meal replacements in the UK.

How did you grow your client base as an Exante Consultant?

'I was my own walking and talking advert, having lost 3 stone using meal replacements after 10 years of diet hopping. It was easy for people to see that this was a successful weight loss tool and because the majority of people want to lose weight using a proven

method, I gained lots of new clients. They then became walking and talking adverts too!'

How much can I expect to earn?

'This is entirely up to you and dependent on how much you work and how quickly you grow your business. As a consultant you are self-employed and earn 31 per cent commission on every sale you make. Exante targets consultants to achieve a minimum of 25 sales per week, however an income in excess of £70k per year is possible for exceptional consultants'

What financial outlay is required?

'At Exante Diet we have kept the start up fee as low as possible so all you pay is £750 for your training and start-up kit which includes everything from business cards to the scales required to weigh your clients. A further £1000 investment is required for your initial stock but once you start recruiting/attracting your first clients they will purchase this stock from you providing you with an immediate income'
